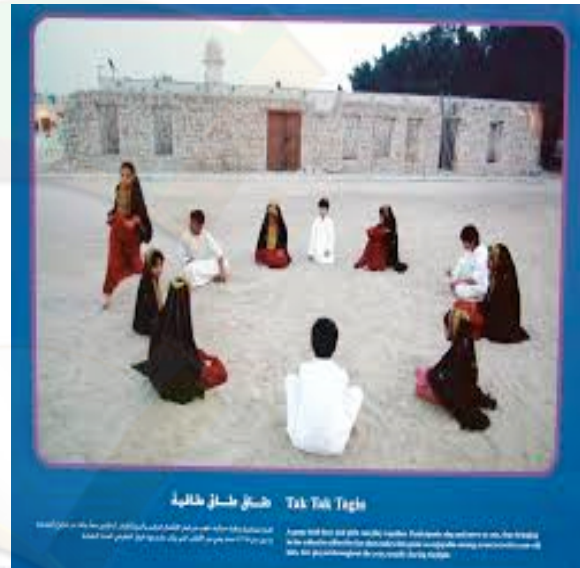

Everyone suffers from diseases at some time or another. However, millions of people around the world do not have health care. Sometimes they have no money to pay for medical treatment. Sometimes they have money but there is no doctor. Sometimes the doctor doesn't know how to treat the disease, and sometimes there is no treatment. When these conditions are present in large population centers, epidemics can start.

Epidemics can spread from one country to another and from one continent to another. Explorations and wars cause different groups of people to come into contact with each other. For example, when the Europeans first came to North and South America, they brought diseases with them that killed about 95 percent of the Native American population. People have all kinds of ideas about how to prevent and treat diseases. Some people think that if you eat lots of onions, you won't get sick. **Others** say you should take huge amounts of vitamins. But scientific experiments have not proved most of these theories. However, people still spend millions of dollars on vitamins and other useless treatments and preventives. Some people waste their money on antibiotics because some diseases are caused by a virus, and antibiotics are useless against viruses. Doctors know how most epidemic

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diseases spread. Some are spread when people sneeze and cough. Others are spread through human beings, such as on the hands. There are also diseases that are spread through insects, such as flies and mosquitoes.

Epidemics usually start in areas of large population. Poor people in big cities who live in miserable conditions have the most health problems. They often have the least education about disease prevention. If they know what to do, they often do not have the money to do it.

Researches continue searching for a way to cure or prevent epidemic diseases. Preventing epidemics is much cheaper than stopping them after they have started.
