When these conditions are present in large population centers, epidemics can start.

Some people waste their money on antibiotics because some diseases are caused by a virus, and antibiotics are useless against viruses. Others are spread through human beings, such as on the hands. There are also diseases that are spread through insects, such as flies and mosquitoes.

Epidemics usually start in areas of large population. Poor people in big cities who live in miserable conditions have the most health problems. They often have the least education about disease prevention. If they know what to do, they often do not have the money to do it.

Researches continue searching for a way to cure or prevent epidemic diseases. Preventing epidemics is much cheaper than stopping them after they have started.
