



Hurricanes are large storms that start in the oceans. Hurricanes gather heat and energy from the warm ocean water. Hurricanes that stay over warm water usually get bigger and stronger, but they weaken once they get over land.

Hurricane clouds move in a circle around a point called the eye, which is the centre of the storm. To be called a hurricane, a storm must have wind speeds of at least 74 miles per hour. When a hurricane comes to land, there are heavy rains, large waves and strong winds that cause damage to buildings, cars and trees. Storm waves are the main reason people are told to leave coastal towns and move to higher ground when a hurricane approaches. Hurricanes move very slowly, so people have a chance to get out of their villages.

During hurricane season, from June 1st to November 30th, scientists watch these storms very carefully so they can tell people how strong a hurricane is and where it is heading. 2005 has been a record year for hurricanes. The Earth has been hit by more hurricanes than in any other year.


