They were a tool for killing many innocent people in world wars.

The Nobel Prize is a set of annual international awards <u>bestowed</u> in a number of categories by Swedish and Norwegian committees in recognition of academic, cultural and scientific advances. The prizes in Chemistry, Literature, Peace, Physics, and Physiology or Medicine were first awarded in 1901. The prizes are awarded in Stockholm, Sweden, except for the peace prize which is awarded in Oslo, Norway. The Nobel Prize is widely regarded as the most prestigious award available in the fields of literature, medicine, physics, chemistry, peace and economics.

Each Nobel Prize consists of a gold medal, a diploma, and a sum of money which is decided by the Nobel Foundation. A Nobel Prize is either given <u>entirely</u> to one person, divided equally between two persons, or shared by three persons. In the latter case, each of the three persons can receive a one-third share of the prize or two together can receive a one-half share. Sometimes a prize is suspended until the following year; if not then awarded, <u>it</u> is paid back into the funds.

The goal of the Nobel Peace Prize is to award people who have done the most or the best work for brotherhood between nations, for the reduction of standing armies and for the holding and promotion of peace conferences. To pick the winners, local governments and parliaments nominate the best people in the academic achievement. The Norwegian Nobel Committee considers all nominees, and selects a "short list" of around five to 20 people for further review. Those candidates are then reviewed with advice from the Committee's permanent advisors and other experts. Finally the committee attempts to reach an agreement on the winner through voting and re-voting. Announcements then take place late in the year.
